Connecting Our Community to Research

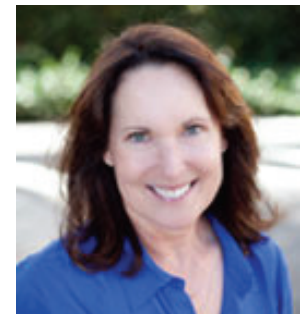
