4 NEW BSF LOGIN

Following a request from the Israel National Cybersecurity Directorate, the US-Israel Binational Foundation (BSF) has made changes to login procedures for its on-line registration and submission system. As a result, you will no longer be able to enter the system with your USERID and password.

Instead, entrance into the BSF on-line system is facilitated via use of email and password that is defined by the registrant. Therefore, all users of the system (applicants, awardees and research administrators) are required to register again with the email address that is used in correspondence with BSF.

If you don't know the email address that is used in BSF correspondence then you can retrieve this by following this link: <http://login.bsf.org.il/ElectronicSubmission/CheckIfRegistered.aspx> (if you received this communication directly from BSF, then use that email address).

First time users of the BSF on-line system need to register by following this link: <http://login.bsf.org.il/login/Account/Register>
