Yale University may nominate one candidate.

PURPOSE

The Vallee Foundation provides flexible **career development support** to outstanding, young independent investigators carrying out **basic biomedical research**. It is expected that Vallee Scholars will be engaged in bold and innovative research.

ELIGIBILITY

- Full-time faculty with the PhD or MD who received the doctoral degree within the last 10 years (March 1, 2008 through March 1, 2018) may apply.
- As of March 1, 2018, candidates cannot have been in an independent research position (tenure-track) for more than 6 years, (having started a tenure-track independent position not earlier than March 1, 2012).
- Researchers who have already received a similar career development award by the March 1, 2018 application deadline are not eligible for nomination.

Within the 2 pages, include:

- project title, abstract, and specific aims;
- a brief introduction/survey of the field;
- proposed research, including preliminary results; and
- indicate your two most significant papers and describe their importance in advancing the field;
- (3) biosketch in the current format (5-page maximum);
- (4) a letter of recommendation from your department chair or section chief that includes a description of the candidate's merits and his or her research.
